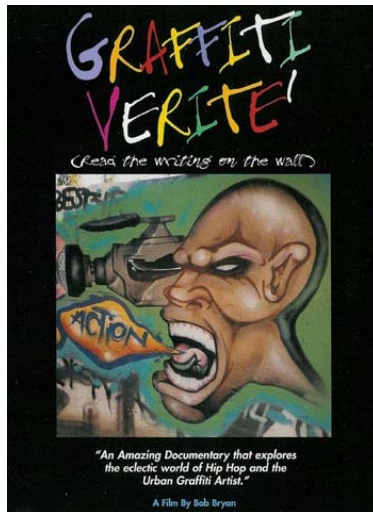


Graffiti Verite' 1: Read the Writing on the Wall – DVD
