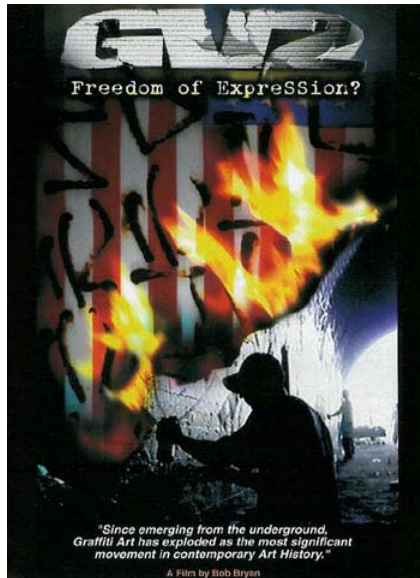


## Graffiti Verite' 2: Freedom of Expression? - DVD



### SYNOPSIS

Flying high above Los Angeles in a "ghetto bird," **GV2** starts out by looking down on our streets, seeking out those artists who ply their incendiary craft on the walls of our cities while we sleep.

**GV2** brilliantly manages to "personalize" 19 Graf artists, moving them elegantly from stereotypes to "real people," revealing the reasons why this movement has become the most popular and powerful cultural force of the millennium.
